Members of the Public Utilities Commission's staff have been communicating with Deuel Harvest Wind project developers, as well as with other state agency officials including those with Gov. Noem's office, about the project's construction given COVID-19. We appreciate and share concerns about contractors and construction workers entering South Dakota given COVID-19, as we strive to protect the people in our communities.

Every wind project permit issued by the commission includes a condition that requires the company to comply with all laws.
