- \* We support the efforts of the wind project and would like to see some of the financial benefits of the project coming into Deuel county.
- \* We live on the north side of Lake Hendricks directly on the Buffalo Ridge and overlook dozens of wind towers to the south of our home on a daily basis. We also have 2 wind towers to the north of our home within a half mile. We have never heard the towers, nor do we find them to be as unsightly as some state. They have become a part of our landscape. (We do find the solar farms to be much more unsightly and disruptive to a rural landscape.)
