Thank you for sharing your opinion of the Deuel Harvest siting permit request, docket EL18-053, currently before the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission.

You relayed your support for the proposed project due to the increase in income it would provide to you and your sister. You asked several specific questions about the project, payments, and location of a road. These questions should be directed to Invenergy as the project developer. My fellow commissioners and I take several factors into account when considering whether or not to grant a wind siting permit. The primary duty of the commission is to ensure the location, construction, and operation of the facilities will produce minimal adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the environment and citizens. The standards we must follow are defined in South Dakota Codified Laws and Administrative Rules.
