Mr. and Ms. Thompson,

Thank you for sharing your opinion of the Deuel Harvest siting permit request, docket EL18-053, currently before the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission.

You relayed your concerns as a non-participating landowner and also on behalf of others in the community that you believe are not in favor of the project. My fellow commissioners and I take several factors into account when considering whether or not to grant a wind siting permit, and you alluded to some of these in your comments. The primary duty of the commission is to ensure the location, construction, and operation of the facilities will produce minimal adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the environment and citizens. The standards we must follow are defined in South Dakota Codified Laws and Administrative Rules.
