51 Q. As a landowner in the Project, do you have concerns regarding the Project 52 and, if so, have those concerns been addressed?

55 Q. What does the Project mean for you and your family?

A. The Project provides a diverse and stable source of additional income and is a great opportunity to maximize the use of our property and diversify our farming operation.
This Project also represents a long-term future for my family because it would create opportunities for our future generations to make futures for themselves here. It is becoming more and more difficult to make a living in the agricultural business, and the Project, along with others like it, provides a way for future generations, such as my grandchildren, to be able to buy land and actually make a living off the land

because the wind adds to the income potential of the land with no real downside tothe production of the other crops on the land.

66 Q. In your view, how will the Project benefit the community?

67 A. The Project will benefit the community through generating tax revenues and 68 providing landowners with additional income that they will be able to invest in the 69 community. Local businesses will benefit from the additional income landowners 70 receive from the Project. The Project will increase the local tax base and generate tax 71 revenue for the community which can be used to provide much-needed funding for local 72 schools and improving local roads. South Dakota has a lot of wind energy to spare, and 73 the Project is an opportunity to use that resource for the benefit of the community. 74 Additionally, the additional income earned by participating landowners in the area will 75 benefit the local economy.

77 Q. Is there anything else you would like to say about the Project?

A. Yes. First, I believe there have been too many testimonials from people based on
something they read on the internet with no real basis in science or fact. I believe
strongly that science and practicality should win out.

82 Additionally, I would like to respond to some remarks made in the testimony of 83 intervenors regarding "absentee" landowners in the Project Area. I may not live in 84 the Project Area, but my family earns our livelihood off the land I have signed up for 85 the Project – I rely on that land. I did sign up to participate in a wind project where I 86 reside - the Flying Cow Wind Project. When I was making the decision to 87 participate in that project, I visited a landowner who actually lives among wind 88 turbines and learned about his experiences. While that project unfortunately did not 89 get built where I reside, I would have no problems living among wind turbines, and I 90 wish that I would have been able to participate in that project, as well.
