Description of occupancy: Placement of sand and wooden mats on SD 20 to move a crane over the highway. Removal of items.

Purpose of occupancy: To move a crane from south of SD Highway 20 to north of SD Highway 20.

I, the undersigned, request permission to occupy public right-of-way at the above location and as shown on the attached layout sheet. In consideration for this permission, I agree to abide by all conditions as herein stated.

1. To furnish all materials, labor, incidentals and pay all costs involved with this occupancy including restoration of any damage to the roadway and right-of-way to equal or better conditions than existed prior to the occupancy covered by this permit.
2. To provide protection to highway traffic during occupancy by the use of proper signs, barricades, flagpersons and lights as prescribed in the "Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices."
3. To indemnify and hold the State of South Dakota, its Department of Transportation, its officers, agents and employees, harmless from and against any and all actions, suits, damages, liability or other proceedings of any kind or nature brought because of any injuries or damage received or sustained by any person or property on account of the use or occupancy of right-of-way designated in this application.

Exhibit A – Conditions of permit for Mortenson Construction, 2021 Crane crossing

An exact date for the crossing must be given. Law enforcement (SD Highway Patrol), Emergency Management, Emergency Services, Local Government Entities and SDDOT shall be notified at least two weeks in advance.

- Documentation of all communication with the entities must be submitted to SDDOT prior to any closure.

A press release shall be sent out 10 days & 24 hours in advance of the crossing to local newspaper and radio stations – you must coordinate with SDDOT to announce the press release accordingly through the department media contacts.

SD Highway 20 shall only be closed between the hours of midnight and 4 a.m. for a maximum of 2 hours during that time.

Detour route will be provided as per detour detail attached from Traffic Solutions, Inc. The detour route must have approval granted for use by the county or township that has jurisdiction of the routes..

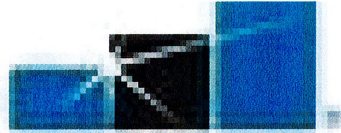
The traffic control plan submitted by Traffic Solutions, Inc. and attached shall be used. Message boards shall have message “SD Highway 20 closed ahead – Use Detour” or similar message using no more than two frames.

A platform shall be built to track the crane across the highway in accordance with the attachment “Temporary Crane Crossing for Existing Roads”.

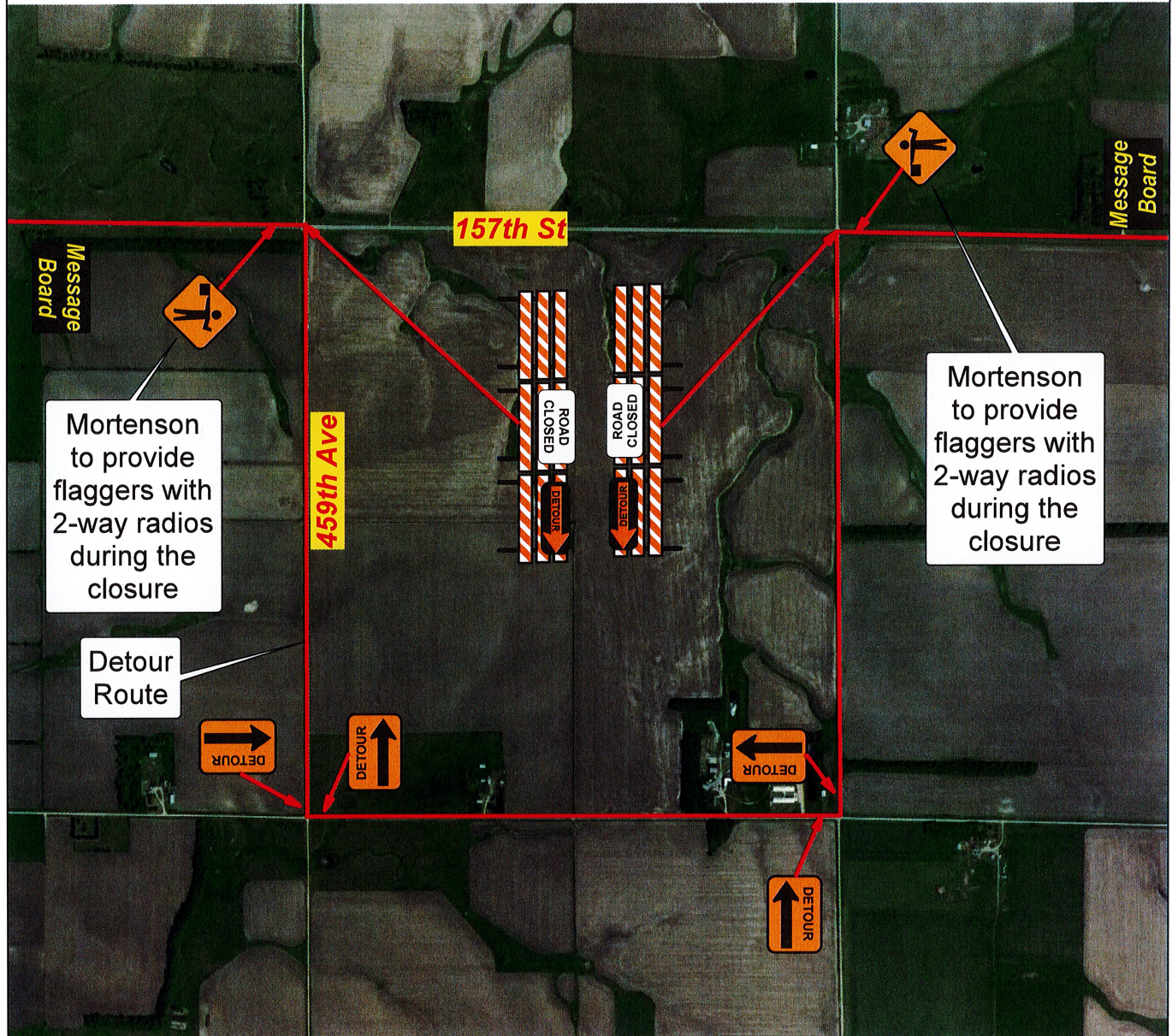
The Platform must be completely removed from the right of way immediately after crane has crossed. The roadway shall be thoroughly swept, cleaned and the entire right of way left in a safe condition for traffic before re-opening.

Any damage to the Highway ROW, Roadway, Pavement Markings, Signage, Vegetation, or anything else within the ROW shall be immediately restored at the permittee’s expense according to SDDOT standards.

Temporary accesses must be constructed in accordance with attached standard plate 120.01. Drainage must be maintained through these temporary accesses and the accesses must be removed completely within 14 calendar days after the crane crossing.

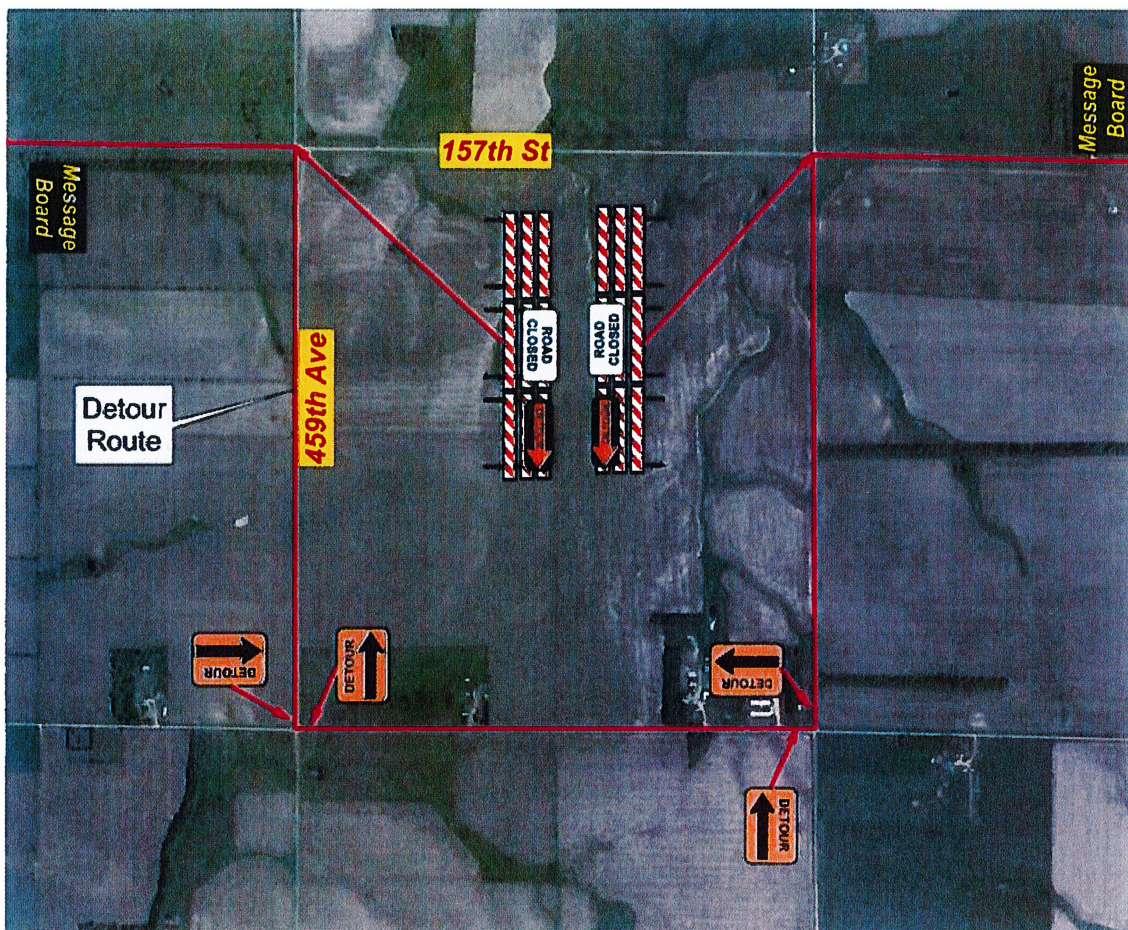

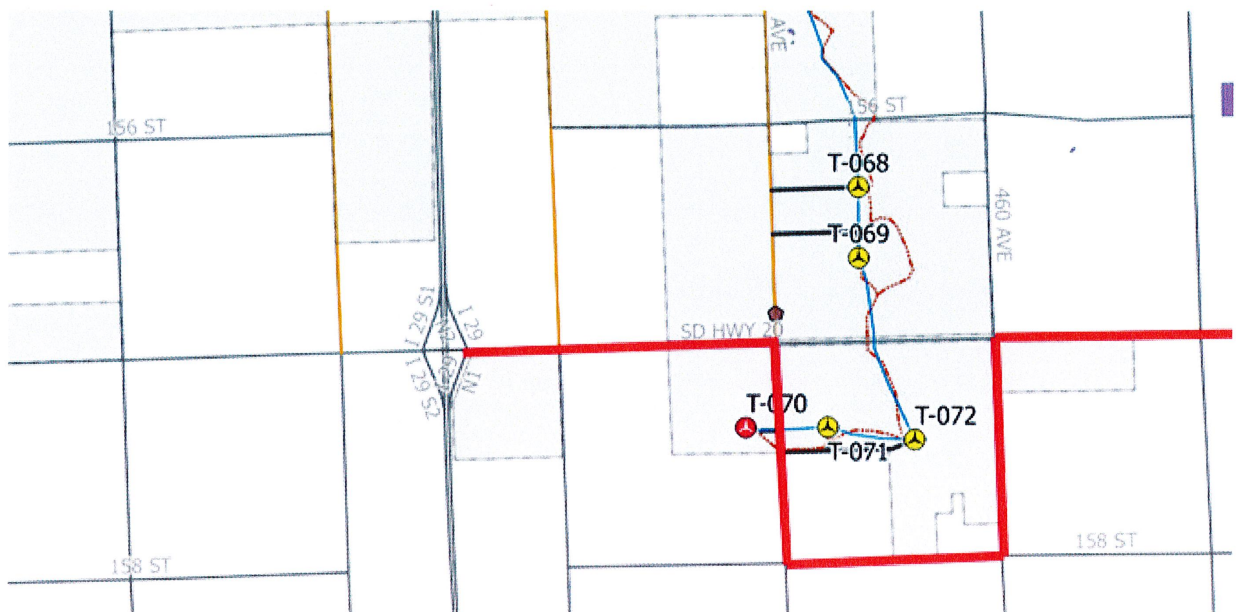

Hello Lynn,

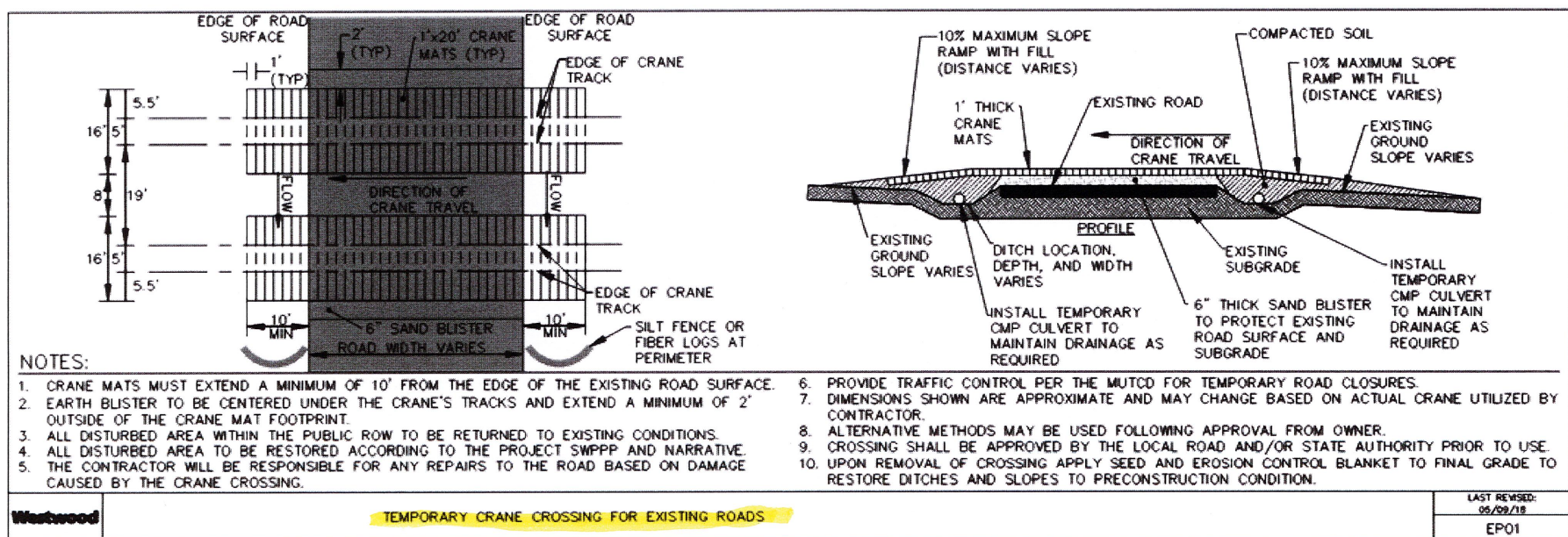
