WHERE: Deubrook Elementary 695 Palisades

Pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-15 and 49-41B-16, published notice of a public input hearing was given to construct an approximately 10.42 mile transmission line for the Project in Deuel County, South Dakota. The Project is proposed by Roaring Fork Wind, LLC, the joint venture of Energy Systems Americas Inc., and Roaring Fork Energy. The Project is located in Township 114N, Range 47W, Section 14 of Section 22, Township 113N, Range 47W, Deuel County, South Dakota, expected to be in service by the third quarter of 2018. On November 5, 2018, the Commission requested to Withdraw the Application for the Project. Pursuant to this Order, this Public Hearing is cancelled.
