## Notice for Start of Construction and Appointment of Public Liaison Officer

Dear Landowner/Law Enforcement Agency/Local Government:

Deuel Harvest Wind Energy LLC (“Deuel Harvest”) plans to commence construction of the Deuel Harvest North Wind Farm (“Project”) in Deuel County, South Dakota, on or after November 4, 2019. Enclosed for your information, please find the following Project-related documents:

1. A copy of the May 30, 2019 Final Decision and Order Granting Permit to Construct Facilities; Notice of Entry issued by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) to Deuel Harvest for the Project; and
2. Project construction/maintenance damage compensation plans and procedures (confidential) (only to participating landowners).

For your safety and the safety of the workers on the Project, we thank you in advance for your cooperation in the following safety practices:

- **Turbine worksites:** The Project involves many individual worksites. These worksites will involve heavy equipment and many moving parts. Please do not enter the worksites, either while workers are present or while workers are not present. We ask that you obey all warning signs and do not enter coned or taped off areas.
- **Road worksites:** The Project includes improving some roadways and working alongside the road. When workers are present, please reduce speeds to 30 mph or less and obey all warning signs. Watch for flaggers, who may occasionally slow or stop traffic. Be prepared for altered traffic patterns. While we will do our best to reduce temporary road closures, some may be required to protect workers and the public.
- **Wide truck loads:** The Project involves transporting large machinery, equipment and products that are permitted wide loads. Please follow all warning signs and watch for the escort vehicles. While the wide truck loads will do their best to keep traffic flow as normal as possible, they may take some turns slowly or take up more than their side of the road. Please give them the right of way when possible.


