He cannot issue a subpoena himself since he is not an attorney. I see that the administrative rules provide a procedure for this. I have attached the email I sent him yesterday to explain what to do. SDAR 20:10:01:17, provides that he needs to make a written request to the PUC and the PUC will issue the subpoena under the signature of any commissioner. I am sure this is not something you run into very often. Once it's issued, John of course must arrange for its service. Thanks for your help.
