Having received no response whatsoever from my last two requests for information submitted to Crowned Ridge Wind, LLC, it seems obvious to me and my co-intervenor Allen Robish, by and through legal counsel (below), that CRW does not intend to provide information for our informed review of the November 2021 sound study.

It is difficult to understand how a comprehensive analysis of the sound study could be conducted by Staff, Dr. Hessler, our PUC Commissioners and the Intervenors without the pivotal and necessary information that was and is reasonably requested.

With the above concern(s) in mind, Intervenors respectfully request to be added on to the PUC agenda to better attempt to review and discuss the incomplete November 2021 sound study in light of the incomplete and/or denied sound study information concern at the first meeting following the July 5th meeting of the Commission (i.e., no meeting date following July 5th has been posted as of today). Finally, if a formal motion in this regard is actually required after July 5th, please advise and Intervenors will plan to prepare and file, again, if necessary.
