**ANSWER OF
CROWNED RIDGE WIND, LLC**

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:30.02, Crowned Ridge Wind, LLC (“CRW”) respectfully submits an answer to the August 30, 2021 Petition for Reconsideration (“Petition”) of the Commission’s August 26, 2021 Order Denying Motion to Amend Sound Study Mitigation Plan (“Order”). In that Order, the Commission concluded in a 2-1 vote that the July 29, 2021 Motion of Christenson was untimely filed and failed to demonstrate a technical need to add her residence to the Fall of 2021 Sound Study. The Petition raises no new arguments over those already presented in the Motion or raised at the August 19, 2021 Commission meeting. Therefore, the Petition presents no basis for the Commission to rehear or reconsider its Order, and, thus, it should be summarily denied.
