Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

On October 21, 2021, an email from Amber Christenson to the Commissioners and Commission Staff was posted in which Ms. Christenson requested that personal observations be conducted at her location as part of the upcoming sound study. In response to the email, Crowned Ridge Wind, LLC ("Crowned Ridge") commits that Epsilon will visit Ms. Christenson's location (*i.e.*, yard) on a daily basis during the tenure of the sound study. For all locations, routine personal observations will typically be brief and may occur during periods when the homeowner is not present or not aware observations are taking place, *e.g.*, at night. Personal observations, including the potential for an exceedance of the limit, weather, and wind turbine operations will dictate whether extended observations and/or additional observations during a 24-hour period are necessary at a given location. While the time an individual from Epsilon will dedicate to observe Ms. Christenson's location on a daily basis initially will not be the same as the other locations that are being studied due to exceedances indicated in the 2020 sound study, if any of the daily observation(s) at Ms. Christenson's location indicates that additional observations should occur then additional attention to her location will occur.
