Dear PUC Commissioners and staff,

Please deny the waiver request of Crown Ridge I by NextEra Energy. I strongly oppose the waiver as NextEra Energy should have been aware of their failure to meet the Low Noise Trailing Edge (LNTE) blade requirements one would think Crown Ridge I would have asked for an extension months ago. The turbines have not met the requirements agreed to when they signed the application/permit from the PUC. There are reports of other conditions that are not being met. When I look to the north from my street, I see some flashing red lights from the turbines running. Some red lights that are not flashing yet.

I strongly encourage the PUC to deny this waiver and enforce the provisions of the permit. There is a process and the requirements were agreed to by all parties involved.
