
TRANSMISSION RIGHT OF WAY FERMIT

He, Zelianna S. Miser , in consideration of the sum of \$1.00, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants to BLACK HILLS POWER AND LIGHT COMPANK, a Corporation, of Rapid City, S. D. Post Office, its successors and assigns, a perpetual right of way and easement to construct, operate and maintain an electric power line with poles, wires, and all necessary attackments and appurtenances, with the right of ingress and agress therefor, upon over and across that certain piece of real estate hereinafter described, together with the right to trim any trees along said lines where necessary to secure a clearance of at least 20 feet on each side of the center line of said right of way for the conductors.

The real estate above referred to is specifically described as follows: Lot 2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 34, Township 2 North, Runge 7 East, and Lot C of Lot 1 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 34, Township 2 North, Runge 7 East, B.H.M., Pennington County, South Dakota, as shown hereon.



In the event it should become necessary for the purposes of improvement of the described property and request in writing is made therefor, the pole, located as designated hereon, shall be relocated by grantee in a new position within said easement at a point to the West of its designated location to be determined by grantor; provided, however, such relocation shall be made within a distance of 100 feet weat of the designated location.

The foregoing right is granted upon the express condition that the power company will assume liability for all demage to the hereinbefore described property caused by said Company's failure to use due care in its exercise of the granted right.
