**TEMPORARY PERMIT TO USE PUBLIC WATERS
FOR CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES**

This temporary permit to use public waters for construction purposes is issued to Tatanka Ridge Wind LLC, 1125 Couch Street, Suite 700, Portland OR 97209 authorizing withdrawal of ground water and/or storm water in excavations located as follows:

- Sections 24 & 25, T114N, R50W
- Sections 29, 31, 32, 34 & 35, T114N, R49W
- Section 1, T113N, R50W
- Sections 2-5 and 8-12, T113N, R49W
- Sections 6-7, 16-17, 21-22, T113N, R48W

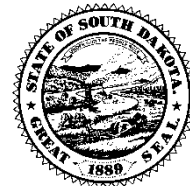
The "Tatanka Ridge Wind Project" to be located in Deuel County, involves construction of up to 56 turbines and associated infrastructure including access roads, substation, O&M building, switchyard, laydown yard, temporary concrete plant, underground collection and overhead transmission line.

Any discharge of water must comply with the "General Permit for Stormwater Discharges" issued by this Department (*The General Permit for Stormwater Discharges is issued as a separate permit*).

This temporary permit becomes effective April 16, 2020 and expires on December 31, 2020.

This permit does not provide necessary right-of-way. Such arrangements should be made with the proper landowner. Issuance of this temporary permit deals with the withdrawal of water only. It does not address other concerns or permitting issues from other State or Federal entities.
