As required by Condition No. 9 of the Final Order, Crowned Ridge Wind II, LLC ("Crowned Ridge Wind II") files a "Temporary Traffic Control Plan and provide signage, vehicle lighting, and/or flagging that identifies road closures and disturbances resulting from the Project in accordance with the most recent edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as published by the Federal Highway Administration."

Crowned Ridge Wind II does not plan to impede traffic during construction, and, therefore, the only practice recommended in the most recent edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices applicable to Crowned Ridge Wind II involves informing drivers of the additional trucks entering and exiting the batch plant/laydown yard. Crowned Ridge Wind II will satisfy this recommended practice with signage as reflected on Sheet 3 of the Attachment 1, which is consistent with examples of such signage set forth in the Manual.

Also, in its April 7, 2020 Pre-Construction Filing, Crowned Ridge Wind II indicated that:

The preconstruction design shows two batch plant locations. The eastern location is the preferred location, because it is farther from the residence and will provide access off county road 289 in addition to off US Hwy 212, minimizing the heavy truck traffic pulling into and out of traffic on the highway. We will finalize the batch plant location prior to the start of construction.

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Crowned Ridge Wind II will use the preferred eastern location for the batch plant. Crowned Ridge Wind II has land rights to use the eastern location and is finalizing its use with the South Dakota Department of Transportation.
