2-2) Provide an updated sound study incorporating the lack of LNTE attachments in the Crowned Ridge 1 project.

Response: Crowned Ridge Wind II objects to Data Request 3-2 because it seeks a study that is not relevant and is not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence in this proceeding before the PUC, given that the LNTE attachments for Crowned Ridge Wind I will be installed on or before September 15, 2020 well prior to the Crowned Ridge Wind II becoming operational in the fourth quarter of October of 2020.

Without waiving and subject to the objection, Crowned Ridge Wind I responds that it constructed nameplate 2.3 MW wind turbines in the General Electric 2 MW 116 model series.
