Community project description:

The Blue Dragon Academy (501 c3) moved into a new facility on June 4, 2019. This was a \$900,000.+ project. We have raised around \$200,000. and have borrowed the rest. Our budget for the playground was very lean. We put up the fence and put down artificial turf. We have made do with what we had for toys on the playground and the school age kids only have balls to play with. We have chosen not to put up expensive playground equipment. We want to implement toys that are more natural and items that encourage imaginative play. We recently have been introduced to Imagination Playground Company that make huge foam type blocks that children can make structures. Sanford Health purchased the blocks for the Levitt Band Shell. Our staff saw them at a concert and the kids were intrigued with the unique blocks and were occupied during the entire concert. We feel these blocks would fit in great on our outdoor play area for our school age children. They are also mobile so we can bring to community outdoor events in the city such as community church services, Jesse James events for children, etc.

<u>Benefit to Community</u>: Enhancements to the daycare are a quality of life action that benefits all children at the daycare. Having a reputable daycare that provides safe and educational programs is essential to economic growth to a community. The reasons we built a new daycare in Garretson was because we were at capacity and our old buildings were very old and were not appealing to new young families wanting to move to our community. We had one family that was going to buy a house in Garretson prior to our new building but decided not to at closing because they could not find daycare. We are very proud of our new building. When we give tours of our facility now to new families they are very impressed. A daycare definitely is an important segment of the economic growth of a community. Our building is licensed for 103 children. Our old buildings held 80 children.



Community project description:

Our project involves purchase and installation of a new pumping system in our city swimming pool. We have obtained a quote from MC&R Pools, Inc. of Sioux Falls for the project, which includes removal of the existing plumbing and installation of a new 7.5 horsepower pump and piping. The current pumping system, which was installed about 15 years ago, is too small and therefore unable to filter the pool properly to maintain the pH levels needed to operate safely. Despite our best efforts, we have had to close the pool several days each summer for the past few years when the chemicals were not in balance, and the problem is getting worse.

Benefit to Community:

The Emery swimming pool is the only public pool in Hanson County, so it is an important asset for our community and the surrounding area. On a typical summer day, about 50 to 75 people use the pool. We issued 50 family passes and 15 single passes this year, and 120 people took swim lessons. We have a large circle from surrounding communities that utilize the pool, including people from Bridgewater, Alexandria, and Spencer.


