26	Q.	How many landowners are in the project area?		
27	A.	Currently there are 14,129 acres signed under easement, representing 29 parcels, with		
28	some landowners owning multiple parcels. There are approximately 29 landowners participating			
29	with their land under easement in the Meridian Wind Project.			
30	Q.	Do they all have the same agreement?		
31	A.	Yes.		
32	Q.	How long has this project been under development?		
33	A.	Since 2015		
34	Q.	Can you detail your efforts for the commission?		
35	A.	As a land agent, I am the main point of contact between the land owners and the project		
36	developers. I provide information regarding the details of the project, the progress of the wind			
37	development efforts, explaining the details of the Easement for Wind Energy Development that			
38	is presented to all landowners in the project area. My goal is to have a sufficient number of land			
39	owners enter into the easement agreement in order to successfully develop the wind project.
