Dear Landowner:

Wild Springs Solar, LLC (“Wild Springs”) plans to commence construction of the Wild Springs Solar Project (“Project”) in Pennington County, South Dakota, on October 20, 2022. Enclosed for your information, please find the following Project-related documents:

1. A copy of the Final Decision and Order Granting Permit to Construct Facilities and Notice of Entry (“Order”), issued by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) to Wild Springs for the Project.
2. Project construction/maintenance damage compensation plans and procedures [CONFIDENTIAL].

Wild Springs has entered into an agreement with Ames Construction (“Ames”), who will be constructing the Project.

For your safety and the safety of the workers on the Project, we thank you in advance for your cooperation in the following safety practices:

- **Solar array worksites:** The Project involves multiple individual worksites. These worksites will involve heavy equipment and many moving parts. Please do not enter the worksites, either while workers are present or while workers are not present. We ask that you obey all warning signs and do not enter coned or taped off areas.
- **Road worksites:** The Project includes improving some roadways and working alongside the road. When workers are present, please reduce speeds to 30 mph or less and obey all warning signs. Watch for flaggers, who may occasionally slow or stop traffic. Be prepared for altered traffic patterns. While we will do our best to reduce temporary road closures, some may be required to protect workers and the public.
- **Construction traffic:** The Project involves transporting construction materials, facility components, and personnel. Please follow all warning signs and watch for the escort vehicles. While the construction vehicles will do their best to keep traffic flow as normal as possible, slow-moving construction vehicles may cause delays on smaller roads, similar to the impact of farm equipment during planting or harvest. Please give them the right of way when possible.
