Applicant Wild Springs Solar, LLC ("Wild Springs"), by and through counsel, hereby requests permission from the Commission to allow its witnesses, representatives, and counsel to appear via video conference, or telephonically if video conference is not available, for the Evidentiary Hearing scheduled in this matter beginning December 15, 2020.

Wild Springs' witnesses, representatives, and counsel are all located in Minnesota, and they would need to travel and secure overnight accommodations in order to attend the Evidentiary Hearing in person. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, traveling and overnight accommodations pose potential health risks that would be avoided by participating in the Evidentiary Hearing by remote means. Additionally, only one issue remains unresolved amongst the parties and, therefore, the scope and time required for the Evidentiary Hearing should be limited.
