General Provisions Rate 100 Tariffs

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) herewith advises the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) of the Company's intent to deviate from its General Provisions Rate 100 gas and electric tariffs and waive the Late Payment Charge (LPC) provision provided for under these tariffs starting April 1, 2020.

Currently Montana-Dakota's Rate 100 tariffs provide for the application of a LPC equal to one percent per month on past due balances. The Company's intent is to now waive the application of the LPCs in order to assist customers who may be experiencing hardships incurred from the recent COVID-19 circumstances. The Company will waive the application of the LPCs starting April 1, 2020 and continue until the COVID-19 related hardships affecting the Company's customers declines. Montana-Dakota will advise the Commission of the re-application of the LPCs prior to its re-instatement.
