MOTION TO CLARIFY HEARING SCOPE

COMES NOW, the Applicant, by and through its counsel of record, and moves the Commission for an order clarifying the scope of the upcoming hearing.

The Commission's Prehearing Order listed the four (4) factors in SDCL 49-41B-22 as the burden required for Applicant to meet in order to obtain a permit from the Commission. Applicant hereby advises the Commission that it has conditional use permits from both Hyde and Hughes Counties and will introduce both conditional use permits into evidence at the upcoming hearing. Pursuant to statute, the Applicant's burden would be reduced based on the conditional use permits. *See* SDCL 49-41B-22.

The pre-filed evidence in the docket, to date, appears to implicate a number of the factors in the reduced burden. It appears that there is a substantial amount of evidence which need not be concurred or considered by the Commission. The Commission, the Staff, and the Parties would benefit from an order clarifying how the Commission would like to receive the evidence and how much/what testimony is required. For example, the Applicant's application attempts to meet the full burden under law. The conditional use permit from Hughes County is later than the application date. It seems possible for the Commission to receive that application in total and only consider the portions necessary in order to meet the reduced burden. However, accepting testimony on those sections would seem to be burdensome and outside the scope of the hearing.

Whereupon the Applicant requests that the Commission consider and enter an Order Clarifying the Scope of the upcoming evidentiary hearing.
