**ORDER GRANTING  
INTERVENTION**

**EL21-011**

On March 19, 2021, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Black Hills Power, Inc., dba Black Hills Energy (Black Hills) requesting approval to amend its existing Cogeneration and Small Power Production Service Tariff to become its QF Service Tariff. Black Hills states this amendment will put in place conditions of service for customers installing behind-the-meter generation that are fair for all Black Hills customers. Black Hills proposes the revised rates and terms of service be effective for qualifying generation facilities placed into operation on or after June 1, 2021, and that existing customers with qualifying facilities be exempt from the terms of the amended QF Service Tariff until May 31, 2041.

On March 25, 2021, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 9, 2021, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. On April 14, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Granting Intervention (Richard Bell and R. Sonny Rivers). Petitions to intervene were received on April 13, 2021, from Kevin Crosby, Xanterra Parks & Resorts, Inc; on April 20, 2021, from Eric T. Davis on behalf of Cobblestone LLC, Pangea Design Group LLC, and Black Hills Homestead; on April 21, 2021, from Lee DeLange, GenPro Energy Solutions; and on April 28, 2021, from Steve and Lynn Hammond.

The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-1, and 49-34A, and ARSD 20:10:01:15.02 through 20:10:01:15.05.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on April 29, 2021, the Commission considered the petitions for intervention. Neither Commission staff nor Black Hills objected to granting intervention to the above-named applicants. Finding that the petitions to intervene demonstrated good cause to grant intervention, the Commission voted unanimously to grant intervention status to Xanterra Parks & Resorts, Inc., Cobblestone, LLC, Pangea Design Group, LLC, Black Hills Homestead, GenPro Energy Solutions, LLC, and Steve and Lynn Hammond. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Xanterra Parks & Resorts, Inc., Cobblestone, LLC, Pangea Design Group, LLC, Black Hills Homestead, GenPro Energy Solutions, LLC, and Steve and Lynn Hammond's Petitions for Intervention are hereby granted.
