**ORDER APPROVING
TARIFF REVISIONS**

On February 1, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy (Black Hills Energy) requesting approval of a Light Emitting Diode (LED) Option for Street Lighting Service Customers. The proposed change will allow Black Hills Energy to offer an LED lighting option in its tariff.

On February 3, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of February 18, 2022, to interested entities and persons on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, 49-34A-12, 49-34A-93, and ARSD 20:10:13:02 through 20:10:13:28.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on March 29, 2022, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval of the tariff revisions with an April 1, 2022, effective date. Finding the revisions to be just and reasonable, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the revisions, effective April 1, 2022. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Black Hills Energy's request to revise its aforementioned tariff page is hereby granted and the revisions are approved, effective for services rendered on and after April 1, 2022.
