ORDER SUSPENDING
OPERATION OF PROPOSED
RATES; ORDER ASSESSING
FILING FEE; ORDER
AUTHORIZING CONSULTING
CONTRACTS

On June 30, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application by Northern States Power Company dba Xcel Energy (Xcel) for approval to increase rates for electric service to customers in its South Dakota service territory by approximately \$44.1 million annually or approximately 17.9% based on Xcel's 2021 historic test year (Application). Xcel states a typical residential electric customer using 750 kWh per month would see an increase of \$19.58 per month. The proposed changes may affect approximately 97,500 customers.

On July 7, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of September 16, 2022, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv.

SDCL 49-34A-14 authorizes the Commission to suspend the operation of the proposed rates for 180 days following the date on which the proposed rates were filed. SDCL 49-1A-8 authorizes the Commission to require a deposit of up to \$250,000 in the Commission's Regulatory Assessment Fee fund to defray Commission expenses incident to analyzing and ruling upon an application to increase rates as part of a general rate case.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-1A, 49-34A and ARSD Chapter 20:10:13.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on July 19, 2022, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to suspend the operation of the schedule of rates proposed by Xcel for 180 days after the Application filing date of June 30, 2022. The Commission further voted unanimously to assess Xcel a filing fee up to the statutory limit of \$250,000 for expenses related to the general rate case and to give the executive director authority to enter into consulting contracts. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the proposed schedule of rates shall be suspended for 180 days after the Application filing date of June 30, 2022. It is further

ORDERED, that Xcel shall be assessed a filing fee in an amount up to the statutory limit of \$250,000 for expenses related to the general rate case, with payments made to the Commission's Regulatory Assessment Fee fund as periodically billed by the Commission. It is further

ORDERED, that the executive director shall have the authority to enter into necessary

## consulting contracts.
