**ORDER MEMORIALIZING
TERRITORY BOUNDARY**

On October 11, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a joint petition from NorthWestern Corporation dba NorthWestern Energy (NorthWestern) and Clay-Union Electric Inc. (Clay-Union) requesting the Commission approve an electric service agreement. The agreement will allow NorthWestern to serve an existing Clay-Union customer and the proposed operations expansion at 3302 E. Highway 50, Yankton, South Dakota.

On October 13, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of October 28, 2022, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-42 through 49-34A-44.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on November 8, 2022, the Commission considered this matter. Finding that the electric service agreement clarifies the customer's request and the territory boundaries between NorthWestern and Clay-Union, the Commission voted unanimously to memorialize the territory boundary between NorthWestern and Clay-Union to reflect the details in the filed electric service agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the territory boundary between NorthWestern Energy and Clay-Union Electric Inc. is memorialized.
