1-3. Provide a brief narrative explaining why the off-peak summer energy credit decreased while the other three credits increased.

Response: There are several differences in the inputs that result in the differences seen, but a key reason for the summer off-peak energy credit decrease is the lower electric price forecast compared to the 2020 filing. This results in lower coal generation production forecast for the summer off-peak periods. Lower production was replaced by energy purchases at lower forecasted energy market prices which partially offset the impact from lower coal production.
