EL07-025

On August 6, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a request seeking Commission approval of an Addendum to Agreement Regarding Assigned Service Area between Codington-Clark Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Codington-Clark) and the City of Watertown (City). On August 5, 1998, the Commission approved an Agreement between Codington-Clark and the City regarding their assigned service area. The Agreement was for a three year term, which expired on July 23, 2001. The parties entered into an Addendum to that Agreement for the purpose of renewing the Agreement until July 23, 2004. Subsequently, the parties entered into another Addendum to that Agreement which renewed the Agreement until July 23, 2007. This filing is for approval of a new Addendum to Agreement Regarding Assigned Service Area providing for the extension of the agreement in perpetuity.

On October 23, 2007, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered the request for approval of the Addendum to Agreement Regarding Assigned Service Area. Commission Staff recommended approval.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A. specifically, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-42, and 49-34A-55. The Commission clarified that the Addendum to Agreement Regarding Assigned Service Area does not permit the parties to modify their service area territory without Commission approval. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that the request seeking approval of the Addendum to Agreement Regarding Assigned Service Area between Codington-Clark and the City for an extension of the agreement in perpetuity is hereby approved.

ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT REGARDING ASSIGNED SERVICE AREA

This Addendum is made this <u>20</u> day of <u>September</u>, 2007, to the AGREEMENT TO MODIFY ASSIGNED SERVICE AREA BETWEEN CODINGTON-CLARK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., AND CITY OF WATERTOWN, SOUTH DAKOTA dated December 3, 1993,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Codington Clark Electric Cooperative, Inc., and the City of Watertown, South Dakota, on December 3, 1993, entered into an agreement to modify assigned service area, and

WHEREAS, said agreement provided that the parties could modify the same by mutual consent, and

WHEREAS the parties amended the said agreement by Addendum dated July 27, 1998, and Addendum dated June 21, 2001, and Addendum dated June 24, 2004, and

WHEREAS the parties wish to extend the term of the said agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE,

IN CONSIDERATION the mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed that the said agreement to modify assigned service area is amended by providing that the term thereof shall be perpetual.

The parties agree to submit this Addendum to the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission for its approval. If the Commission grants approval for the extension of the term to a period less than perpetual, then the term of this agreement shall be the period so approved by the Commission.
