- *lowa Wind Energy FACT Sheet June 2022 wind turbines were producing 57% of energy.
- *directly employed 3953 lowans in 2020 including manufacturing, operations and maintenance.
- *wind energy accounts for at least \$22 billion in capital investment in lowa
- *wind turbines generate \$67 million annually in lease payments to landowners

*wind projects contribute approximately \$57 million in tax revenue in 2021

*3 examples of 2016 county tax revenue for wind Adair county received \$5.9 million, Cass county received \$2.7 million and Franklin county received \$3 million.

This revenue supported schools, roads and bridges, hospitals and more. It is no doubt that wind farms in South Dakota are and will be an important component of prosperity for landowners, the business communities, schools, improvements of infrastructure in rural areas and towns.

So in closing, I just want to comment that most landowners are in the business of producing income from their property. That is how our economy works. So when an opportunity presents itself that a company like Invenergy is willing to invest their resources in the South Deuel Wind Project, I feel it is advantageous to the community and State PUC to proceed with the project. I have attended several meetings and I am satisfied Invenergy has done their due diligence and are ready to expand their operation in South Deuel county.
