On residential page 10 of the revised booklet, explain why "Tree Trimming" was removed from the table.

Response:

We originally removed the Tree Trimming section due to the confusion it causes for customers. Many customers believe we will prune or remove trees on their property and haul away the branches and wood at no charge. Customers are then disappointed to learn they might have to hire a qualified tree trimmer to fully prune or remove the tree. We do trim the portion of a tree that is closest to a power line to create a "safety zone" for the customer or their contractor to finish pruning or removing the tree.

We propose adding revised language as follows:
