### **Ballpark Improvements**

The Emery Ballpark received extensive damage from the May 2022 Derecho. The Emery Summer Rec Group is eagerly working to repair the damage and make necessary and needed improvements to the ballpark facility. The plan is to redesign the backstop and build new and improved dugouts engineered with safety in mind. In addition, the ballpark lights are old and most recently some lights have even come loose and fallen down. This is a major safety concern so the Emery Summer Rec Group would like to replace all the lights with newer energy efficient LED lights. LED lights will be more economical to use and will provide the ample lighting to ensure that baseball/softball players can see when they are playing into the evening.

#### Benefit to Community:

The Emery community is proud of its Summer Rec Program. Volunteers make up the Emery Summer Rec Group which hires coaches, supervises the baseball/softball programs, runs the concessions stand and organizes fundraisers to help keep the facility safe as well as looking top notch. Approximately 130 youth ages 5 through 16 participate in Emery Summer Rec baseball/softball programs. This includes youth from surrounding towns of Bridgewater and Spencer. Emery Summer Rec program provides much needed recreational opportunity for the youth and in turn provides entertainment for the community. In addition, the Dimock Emery Raptors host amateur baseball games which also have a strong community following. The Raptors bring young and old to games and to the community.



Thank you again for Xcel Energy's ongoing commitment to economic development in our state and region. In particular I want to thank you for your ongoing support of the South Dakota Small Business Development Center Network, which in addition to the SBDC includes the APEX Accelerator and the Small Business Innovation Research Programs.

In calendar year 2024, the SBDC maintained a high level of service, working with almost 1,000 clients in the past year. Those clients started 79 new businesses, created 704 jobs, and injected \$92.8 MM of new capital into our state's economy.

Federal funding levels continue to remain flat for the SBDC program, making investments from outside partners, such as Xcel, increasingly important. Specifically we have tasked the \$10,000 we receive from Xcel to the support of one of our business advisors in the Sioux Falls office.

You will be glad to know that in the past year, this advisor counseled 144 clients who started 16 new businesses, created or retained 166 jobs and injected over \$20.7MM of new capital into the Sioux Falls MSA, which is the service territory for our Sioux Falls office.

All of the Xcel funds were used to provide direct service and support to the sustainability of the organization and <u>none of the funds were used for lobbying</u>.
