## Data Request:

Does Otter Tail provide non-firm electric service to other customers in South Dakota? If yes, how many and under which rate schedules? Are these customers subject to the EEP charge?

## Response:

Otter Tail Power provides non-firm electric service to customers in South Dakota through controlled service rates. These non-firm loads, however, differ from those considered under the TMEP Rider. Many of the loads served under our controlled service rates are subject to limitations on the number of control hours per 24-hour period or day. Nor are any of these customers' usage tied to and limited by the output of a specific non-OTP-owned generation resource. These loads are subject to the EEP charge. The table below outlines the number of customers enrolled in each controlled service rate, along with the corresponding daily control hour limits.

Rate Schedule	Number of Customers	Hours of Control Allowed During 24-hour Period
Controlled Service - Water Heating (Rate 191)	1,889	14
Controlled Service – Deferred Load (Rates 195, 197)	193	14
Controlled Service – Interruptible (Rates 165, 170, 169, 168, 185, 190)	1,027	24*

<sup>\*</sup>Domestic water heating load under this rate may only be controlled up to 14 hours in the 24-hour period.
