Proposed Customer Notices

Interim Rate Increase Effective December 1, 2025

On June 4, 2025, we asked the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (PUC) for permission to increase our electric rates. Our request won't take effect until it's been reviewed and approved by the PUC.

On June 18, 2025, the PUC ordered the proposed rates be suspended for 180 days, pursuant to South Dakota law, as they considered our request. The 180-day suspension period expired on December 1, 2025.

While the PUC considers our full request, they've granted approval for an interim rate increase beginning December 1, 2025.

Most customers will see approximately a 12.5% increase beginning December 1, 2025, with approved interim rates. We'll accomplish this by applying a rate-specific percentage increase on portions of customer bills. The interim rate adjustment applies to the customer charge, energy charge, demand charge, facilities charge, fixed charge, and the monthly minimum charge. The impact to you may be higher or lower depending on your actual electric use.

This rate increase appears on your bill as Interim Rate Adj for service used on and after December 1, 2025. The first bill you receive may be prorated, depending on the date we read your meter. This means that only the portion of your bill for service on or after December 1, 2025, will reflect the interim rate increase.

The table below shows the approved interim increase on a typical customer's monthly bill in each of our customer classes.

Our Transmission Cost Recovery Rider, and Phase-In Rider will also change (rates will decrease) effective December 1, 2025.
