Mr. Bodine – This is in response to your comments submitted to the Public Utilities Commission. Your comments relate to three separate dockets:

- [EL25-022](#) - In the Matter of the Application of Otter Tail Power Company for Authority to Increase Its Electric Rates in South Dakota, was opened on June 4, 2025. The Commission issued its decision in this docket on March 12, 2026.
- [EL25-024](#) - In the Matter of the Application of Northern States Power Company dba Xcel Energy for Authority to Increase its Electric Rates, was opened on June 30, 2025. The Commission voted on this docket on May 8, 2026.
- [EL26-003](#) - In the Matter of the Application of Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy for Authority to Increase Rates For its Utility Service in South Dakota, was opened on February 19, 2026.

Regarding EL26-003, Black Hills Energy’s request for authority to increase its electric rates, Commission staff analysts and legal counsel are currently conducting a comprehensive review of the company’s financial data, operational needs, and the potential impact on customers. This includes multiple rounds of discovery, during which staff and expert witnesses request and analyze detailed information from the utility. The Public Utilities Commission is committed to a thorough and transparent review. As part of this process, Black Hills Energy is required to provide detailed justification for the proposed increase.
