A concise statement of the last rate case of the filing public utility, whether or not it was concluded at the time of the filing of the current rate increase, shall also be included.

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Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, is headquartered in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Xcel Energy generates, transmits, and distributes electricity to approximately 3.9 million electricity customers and distributes natural gas to about 2.2 million customers.

The Company has regulated operations in South Dakota, Minnesota, North Dakota, Colorado, Michigan, New Mexico, Texas and Wisconsin. NSP-Minnesota (NSPM) operates in South Dakota, North Dakota, and Minnesota.

NSPM provides electric utility service to approximately 1.6 million customers and natural gas utility service to approximately 600,000 customers. NSPM owns 31 generating plants, has 366 electric utility transmission and distribution substations and 120,332 conductor miles of electric utility overhead and underground transmission and distribution lines as of December 31, 2024.

Retail sales for the year ended December 31, 2024 for NSPM were 32,069,399 MWh. South Dakota retail sales accounted for 2,243,625 MWh of that total amount.

Our most recent electric rate case before this Commission was Docket No. EL22-017. That case was filed in June of 2022.
