Dear South Dakota Public Utilities Commission,

My name is Mark Fischer.
My wife Rebecca and I live in rural Deuel County.

One of the biggest reasons we live here is the current quality of life, which to us is priceless! And, to us, quality of life requires a pastoral environment, which we are currently blessed to live in.

A power plant in Deuel County is incompatible with our current agrarian quality of life.

The recent referendum on this proposed power plant we held back on June 2, which Deuel County residents emphatically (by a 2 to 1 vote) defeated, makes it clear that we value quality of life and its requisite pastoral environment over an industrial one.

In light of this, and the fact that there are over 60 other counties in South Dakota that they can see if they'd be ok with industrializing their county, we encourage you to deny this extension.

Please do not allow Missouri River Energy Services to treat us the way that Summit Carbon Solutions Company did to so many South Dakota landowners just a few years ago.
