**AFFIDAVIT OF ALEXANDER  
CHANDLER PROVIDING NOTICE OF  
TURBINE ADJUSTMENT UP TO 250  
FEET**

I, Alexander Chandler, being first duly sworn on oath, state and allege as follows:

1. I am the Project Manager for the Philip Wind Project and associated 230 kV Transmission Line (“Project”), which is owned and being developed by Philip Wind Partners, LLC (“Philip Wind”). I have the authority to provide this affidavit on behalf of Philip Wind.
2. I am providing this Affidavit pursuant to paragraph 22 in accordance with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission’s Order Granting Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation; Order Granting Permits to Construct Facilities (“Order”) for Philip Wind wind energy facility and associated transmission facility, dated February 17, 2026, in the above-referenced docket.
3. Since issuance of the Order, Philip Wind has determined that one (1) turbine adjustment within 250 feet of the location approved by the Commission is needed for the Project. Maps showing the turbine location approved by the Commission and the current turbine location with the adjustment are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
4. A summary of the adjustment is provided below:
  - a. Turbine 16 has been adjusted approximately 100 feet to the north to increase the setback from the 230 kilovolt transmission line.
5. Updated sound and shadow flicker results were submitted on June 13, 2026. These updated results demonstrate that the turbine adjustment complies with all applicable sound and shadow flicker requirements.
6. The minor adjustment is located on land under lease/easement for the Project.
7. The minor turbine adjustment avoids cultural resource impacts and documented habitats for listed species.


8. The minor turbine adjustment avoids potentially undisturbed grasslands.
9. The minor turbine adjustment avoids wetland impacts.
10. With respect to the Project, including the turbine adjustment described herein, Philip Wind will comply with the Commission's Order and all other applicable regulations and requirements.
