I, Alexander Chandler, being first duly sworn on oath, state and allege as follows:

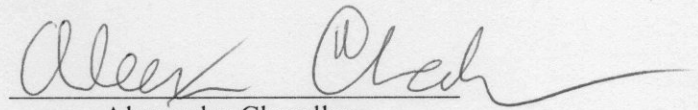
1. I am the Project Manager for the Philip Wind Project and associated 230 kV Transmission Line (“Project”), which is owned and being developed by Philip Wind Partners, LLC (“Philip Wind”). I have the authority to provide this affidavit on behalf of Philip Wind.
2. I am providing this Affidavit pursuant to paragraph 22 in accordance with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission’s Order Granting Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation; Order Granting Permits to Construct Facilities (“Order”) for Philip Wind wind energy facility and associated transmission facility, dated February 17, 2026, in the above-referenced docket.
3. Philip Wind has determined that one (1) turbine adjustment within 250 feet of the location approved by the Commission is needed for the Project. A map showing the turbine location approved by the Commission and the current turbine location with the adjustment are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
4. A summary of the adjustment is provided below:
 - a. Turbine 49 has been adjusted approximately 15 feet to the east to increase the setback from a non-participating landowner.
5. The minor turbine adjustment will not exceed noise and shadow flicker thresholds as specified in the Order.
6. The minor turbine adjustment is located on land under lease/easement for the Project.
7. The minor turbine adjustment avoids impacts on cultural resources impacts and documented habitats for listed species and potentially undisturbed grasslands. Wetland

impacts are avoided or are in compliance with applicable United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) regulations.

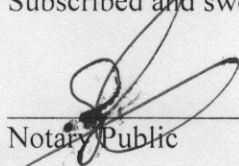
8. With respect to the Project, including the minor turbine adjustment described herein, Philip Wind will comply with the Commission's Order, including shadow flicker and noise limits, and all other applicable regulations and requirements.

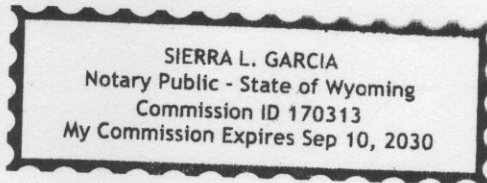

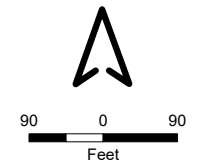
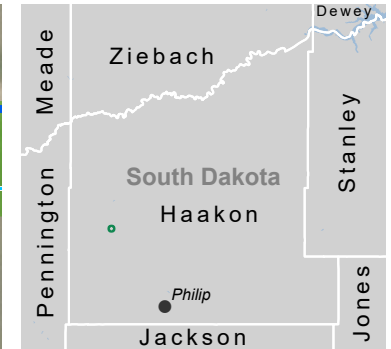
