**JOINT MOTION FOR
ADOPTION OF PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE; JOINT MOTION TO
CONSOLIDATE EVIDENTIARY
HEARINGS

EL25-029**

Staff of the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and Philip Wind Partners, LLC (Philip Wind), together the “Parties”, hereby file this Joint Motion for Adoption of Procedural Schedule and Joint Motion to Consolidate Evidentiary Hearings.

This docket was opened on August 15, 2025, with the filing by Philip Wind for a permit of a wind energy facility and a 230 kV transmission line. The parties in this docket are Staff and Philip Wind.

Under SDCL 49-41B-25, the Commission must issue a decision on this matter within nine months of the filing. Given the time constraints in this docket, Staff requests the Commission adopt the following procedural schedule:

In addition, Staff requests the Commission order that all responses to discovery requests are due 10 business days after service, unless otherwise agreed to, in writing, by the inquiring and responding parties.

Further, to promote administrative efficiency the Staff and Philip Wind request the Commission consolidate the evidentiary hearings pursuant to SDCL 15-6-42(a) for Dockets EL25-029 and EL25-030. This request is made given the filings involve common questions of fact. The Parties agree that these Dockets have slightly different timelines, but given the projects are associated, within the same locations, are likely to pose similar questions at hearing and rely on similar facts, and have common counsel, a joint hearing will likely promote efficiencies for the Commission and for all Parties. However, the Parties do request separate decisions and Orders be issued in the Dockets.

WHEREFORE, Staff and Philip Wind respectfully request the Commission issue an order adopting the above proposed procedural schedule and establishing a ten-business day deadline for responses to discovery requests and consolidating the evidentiary hearings for EL25-029 and EL25-030.
