ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

EL25-032

On September 12, 2025, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Petition by Sweetman Const. Co. dba Knife River (Knife River) to have Xcel Energy (Xcel), assigned as its Electric Provider in the Service Area of Sioux Valley Electric (Sioux Valley). The Petition asks the Commission for an order pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-56 that allows Knife River to take electric service from Xcel, for its proposed rock crushing plant to be located at 25944 482nd Ave., Brandon, South Dakota. The location is currently within the assigned service area of Sioux Valley. Pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-56, new customers at new locations that develop after March 21, 1975, and who require electric service with a contracted minimum demand of two thousand kilowatts or more, are not obligated to take electric service from the electric utility having the assigned service area where the customer is located if the Commission so determines, after consideration of certain factors set forth in statute.

On September 18, 2025, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of October 3, 2025, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filing electronic listsery. On October 27, 2025, Sioux Valley-Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc., East River Electric Power Cooperative, Inc., Basin Electric Power Cooperative, and Xcel Energy were granted intervention. On November 24, 2025, Knife River filed a Motion for a Procedural Schedule. On November 24, 2025, the Commission issued an Order for and Notice of Motions Hearing on Less than Ten Days' Notice. On December 1, 2025, Staff filed a letter regarding Procedural Schedule. No other written positions on the Motion were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on December 2, 2025, the Commission considered this matter. All parties appeared and were represented by counsel. Knife River requested the Commission grant the Motion for Approval of Procedural Schedule. No party objected to the establishment of a procedural schedule, however Sioux Valley offered certain revisions related to discovery deadlines. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the Motion for Approval of a Procedural Schedule filed on November 24, 2025, and to adopt the Procedural Schedule as proposed in the Motion, with the exceptions that responses to discovery are due ten business days after service, the last day to serve discovery will be March 11, 2026, and the responses to final discovery will be due the earlier of ten business days from receipt or April 01, 2026. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Motion for Approval of a Procedural Schedule is granted. It is further ORDERED, that the procedural schedule is established as follows:

ORDERED, that responses to discovery are due ten business days after service of discovery unless a different period is agreed upon by the requesting Party and responding Party. It is further

ORDERED, that prefiled testimony is prerequisite to the offering of testimony at the evidentiary hearing.
