It has been brought to my attention that Mr. Craig Bialas has requested electric service for a residence at location at 27130 404th Avenue, Parkston, South Dakota. His service request will be in the Southwest quarter (SW½) of the Northwest quarter (NW1/4) of Section 30, T100N, R061W, of Starr Township in Hutchinson County, South Dakota. The location of this service will be in the Southeastern Electric Cooperative, Inc's., (Southeastern) service territory as set forth and established by the South Dakota Public Utility Commission (SDPUC).

Douglas Electric Cooperative, Inc., (Douglas) would be required to extend electric service approximately 1400 feet south as noted in Exhibit C. The line extension fee from Douglas for this service is \$4,025.00 (\$350 flat fee for new service + \$3.50 per foot beyond the first 350 feet) in accordance with our standard line extension policy. It is Douglas' understanding that Southeastern will need to extend electric lines more than 1 mile to provide electric service to Mr. Bialas and that your aid to construction may be higher than the cost indicated here by Douglas. Based on our discussions with Mr. Bialas, he has requested Douglas to serve his single phase, residential electric load at the specific location noted above.

Douglas is requesting from Southeastern your permission to serve this electric load for Mr. Bialas at the location listed above.
