

Customer notice

The South Dakota Public Utilities Commission approved our request to update our Transmission Cost Recovery Rider. This rider recovers costs associated with our transmission projects that help us continue to provide you with safe, reliable, and low-cost service.

The table below applies to bills beginning March 1, 2026. A residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity a month will see a bill decrease of \$0.94.
