On February 19, 2026, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application by Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy (BHP) for approval to increase rates for electric service to customers in its South Dakota service territory by approximately \$50.6 million annually or approximately 25.1% based on BHP's test year ending September 30, 2025. The Company states a typical residential electric customer using 650 kWh per month would see an increase of \$25.13 per month. The proposed changes may potentially affect approximately 75,000 customers in BHP's South Dakota service territory.

On February 26, 2026, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 17, 2026, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filing electronic listserv. Comments were received from a number of persons, all of which are available for review on the Commission's web site for this docket. On April 15, 2026, Dakota Panel, Fischer Furniture, Inc., Forest Products Distributors, Inc., GCC Dacotah, Inc., Monument Health Rapid City Hospital, Inc., Pete Lien & Sons, Inc., the South Dakota Science and Technology Authority, and Spearfish Forest Products Inc., collectively referred to as the South Dakota Large Customer Group (SDLCG), filed a Petition to Intervene asking the Commission to grant intervention to each of the individual entities named in the SDLCG Petition.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and SDCL 49-34A, specifically SDCL 1-26-17.1 and ARSD Chapter 20:10:01, specifically 20:10:01:15.02 through 20:10:01:15.05.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 8, 2026, the Commission considered the Petition to Intervene. Neither BHP nor Commission staff objected to the intervention. The Commission found that the Petition to Intervene demonstrated good cause to grant intervention and voted unanimously to grant Dakota Panel, Fischer Furniture, Inc., Forest Products Distributors, Inc., GCC Dacotah, Inc., Monument Health Rapid City Hospital, Inc., Pete Lien & Sons, Inc., the South Dakota Science and Technology Authority, and Spearfish Forest Products Inc., collectively the SDLCG's Petition to Intervene. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the SDLCG's Petition to Intervene is hereby granted and the Commission hereby grants intervention to Dakota Panel, Fischer Furniture, Inc., Forest Products Distributors, Inc., GCC Dacotah, Inc., Monument Health Rapid City Hospital, Inc., Pete Lien & Sons, Inc., the South Dakota Science and Technology Authority, and Spearfish Forest Products Inc..
