**ORDER ASSESSING
FILING FEE; ORDER
AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE
DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO
CONSULTING CONTRACTS**

On June 1, 2026, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Petition by NorthWestern Energy Public Service Corporation dba NorthWestern Energy (NorthWestern) for Approval of its Phase-In Rate Plan Rider (PIRP Rider). NorthWestern proposes to update the PIRP Rider to reflect applicable revenue requirements for the recovery period September 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, including continued recovery of capital investment costs associated with the Aberdeen Generation Station electric generation rebuild and costs related to its continued evaluation of Small Modular Nuclear Reactors (SMR) technology. NorthWestern is also requesting to include costs related to the Aberdeen 3 Generation Station that is currently under development. The proposed rates and monthly impact will vary by customer class. NorthWestern states a typical residential electric customer using an average of 750 kWh per month will be billed at an increase of \$5.01 per month under the proposed PIRP Rider. NorthWestern requests Commission approval of its proposed PIRP Rider with an effective date of September 1, 2026.

On June 4, 2026, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 19, 2026, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. As of the date of this order, no petitions to intervene or comments have been filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically SDCL 49-34A-73 through 49-34A-78.

SDCL 49-34A-77 requires an electric utility filing a petition for a phase-in rate plan rider to pay a filing fee to be determined by the Commission in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, to defray Commission expenses incident to analyzing and ruling upon this type of filing.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on June 18, 2026, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to assess a filing fee as requested by Commission staff up to the statutory limit of \$250,000 to account for actual expenses incurred in review of this filing commencing from the filing date and to give the executive director authority to enter into consulting contracts. It is therefore

ORDERED, that NorthWestern shall be assessed a filing fee pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-77 for actual expenses incurred by the Commission commencing from the filing date not to exceed \$250,000. It is further

ORDERED, that the executive director shall have the authority to enter into necessary consulting contracts.
