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**NET MONTHLY RATE (continued)**

Capacity Credit:

Applicable for generation capacity received only during the summer, and summer on-peak periods defined above.

Capacity credit will be based on current capacity rates, presently ~~\$46.06~~11.91/kW/Year, and will be the lesser amount as determined by either Method 1 or Method 2, as follows:

Method 1 (Optional Time-of-Day):

$$A = \frac{B}{C} \times D$$

where:

- A is the capacity credit.
- B is the kWh delivered during the applicable summer on-peak period.
- C is the number of hours in the applicable summer on-peak period.
- D is the capacity charge of ~~\$11.51~~2.98/kW (~~\$46.06~~11.91 ÷ 4 summer months). I/I

Method 2 (Standard):

$$A = \frac{B}{C} \times D$$

where:

- A is the capacity credit.
- B is the kWh delivered during the applicable summer month.
- C is the number of hours in the applicable summer month.
- D is the capacity charge of ~~\$11.51~~2.98/kW (~~\$46.06~~11.91 ÷ 4 summer months). I/I

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
