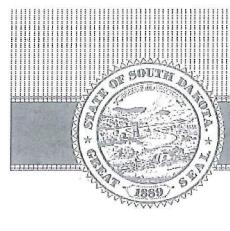

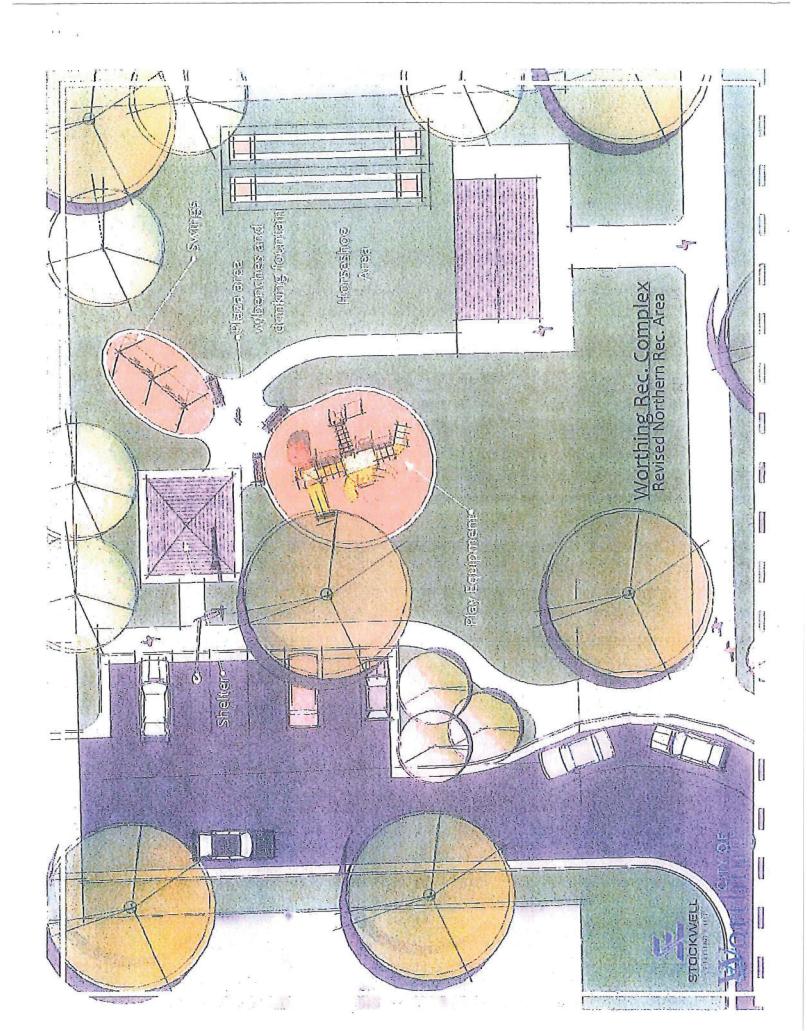

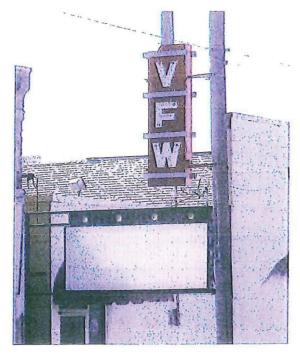

The matching grants will provide assistance to improve the condition of the community's downtown. Street and alley clean-up, colorful banners, landscaping, and lighting all improve the physical image of the downtown as a quality place to shop, work, walk, invest in, and live. The past 2 years, thanks in part to your funding, we have been able to help 8 downtown area businesses with enhancing their facilities. Some of the projects included new signage, new frontage and awnings, new sidewalk and parking area. (see attachments)

Benefit to Community:

Design improvements result in a reinvestment of public and private dollars to downtown. Frequent visible changes in the look and activities of the downtown district will reinforce the perception of positive change. Exterior improvements that will significantly contribute to the revitalization or redevelopment of downtown may attract more business to the area. Small, but dramatic, improvements early in the process will remind the community that the revitalization effort is in progress.

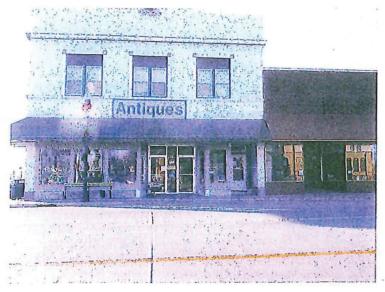

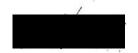
New trash cans were purchase for the downtown area to replace old unattractive trash cans.
