Effective May 1, 2017, the SD Public Utilities Commission approved NorthWestern's revised Energy Efficiency Adjustment (EEA) rate. This change affects all SD retail customers. A residential electric customer using 750 kWh/month will see a decrease of \$0.75 per month or \$0.001 per kWh. A residential natural gas customer using 45 therms/month will see an increase of \$0.68 per month or \$0.0151 per therm. This rate allows NorthWestern to collect/refund the remaining costs of its EEA Program. On June 1, 2017, EEA rates will be set to \$0.00. You may see EEA charges or credits on your June bill due to the timing of your meter read.
