Re: MidAmerican Energy Company's Energy Efficiency Cost Recovery Factor Docket No. GE19-002

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) submits for electronic filing, a request to stop collecting the residential gas Energy Efficiency factor due to projected over-collection, and a tariff change to end the residential electric Energy Efficiency factor due to the end of approved time to collect the factor.

On October 30, 2019, in South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Docket No. GE19-002, the Commission agreed with MidAmerican that these programs are no longer cost effective, and energy efficiency programs should not be offered after 2019. Programs ceased to be offered after December 31, 2019; MidAmerican accepted applications for equipment installed on or before December 31, 2019 through January 31, 2020.

On January 24, 2020, the Commission approved the zeroing out the nonresidential gas and electric factors, effective January 31, 2020 in order to decrease the size of a projected over-collection in these factors. Now, MidAmerican proposes to zero-out the residential gas factor with customers' May bills in order to prevent a similar projected over-collection. Additionally, MidAmerican proposes to zero-out the residential electric factor with customers' June bills because the factor will have reached the end of the approved time to be collected.

In the January 24, 2020, order approving the tariff revisions for nonresidential energy efficiency factors, the Commission also approved MidAmerican to file actual recoveries, actual expenses and a proposed plan for refunds during the month of June. MidAmerican requests to reconcile the residential factors in the same June filing.

The enclosed electric and gas tariff sheets, including a redline version, are being transmitted to you for filing and approval. The filing consists of the following electric and gas tariff sheets:
