Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) submits for electronic filing the reconciliations for the finalization of the electric and gas Energy Efficiency factors.

On October 30, 2019, in South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Docket No. GE19-002, the Commission agreed with MidAmerican that these programs are no longer cost effective, and energy efficiency programs should not be offered after 2019. Programs ceased to be offered after December 31, 2019; MidAmerican accepted applications for equipment installed on or before December 31, 2019, through January 31, 2020.

The Energy Efficiency factors were previously set to zero, in order to minimize projected over-collections. On January 24, 2020, the Commission approved the nonresidential gas and electric factors of \$0.00000, effective January 31, 2020. On April 30, 2020, the Commission approved the factor of \$0.00000 for the residential gas on May 1, 2020, and the electric on June 2, 2020.

In the January 24, 2020, order approving the tariff revisions for nonresidential energy efficiency factors, the Commission also approved MidAmerican to file actual recoveries, actual expenses and a proposed plan for finalization during the month of June. This filing is the proposed plan.

MidAmerican is proposing additional collections for the gas and electric residential factors for the August 2020 through December 2020 billing months, with the factor being reset to zero with the January 2021 billing month. For the gas nonresidential factor, MidAmerican is proposing a refund for the August 2020 through December 2020 billing months, with the factor being reset to \$0.00000 with the January 2021 billing month. The electric nonresidential factor has an over collection of less than \$5,000, hence MidAmerican proposes that this factor be deemed fully reconciled.

The enclosed electric and gas tariff sheets, including a redline version, are being transmitted to you for filing and approval. The filing consists of the following electric and gas tariff sheets:
